**Mackinac Island Ferry**

Dear Valued Customer: PLEASE READ

Thank you for purchasing our Mackinac Island Package. Included in each envelope are your tickets for a round trip on Arnold Line Ferry to Mackinac Island, a Mackinac Island Carriage Tour and entrance into Historic Fort Mackinac.

**Mackinac Island Carriage Tour:**

You must reserve a tour time at the main ticket office of Mackinac Island Carriage Tour. The main office is located just across the street from our dock on Mackinac Island. The tour consists of two parts. The first part tours the downtown, goes past the Grand Hotel and ends a Surrey Hill. To begin the second part of the tour proceed to the other end of the building to catch a larger carriage, which goes through the state Park, stops at Arch Rock and the final stop will be Fort Mackinac where you need to get off to enter the Fort.

Carriage Tour Hours of Operation:

Early May- Mid June	9:00am until 3:00pm
Mid June – Labor Day	9:00am until 5:00pm
Labor Day –Oct 1	9:00am until 3:00pm
Oct 1-Oct 31	9:00am until 2:00pm

**Fort Mackinac:**

Feel free to spend as much time as you like at the Fort. There are two ways to exit the Fort.

#1 We recommend exiting the Fort using the front entrance. It is just a short walk to the downtown.

#2 For those with walking difficulties, we recommend that you re-board the carriage where you enter the Fort. Stay on the carriage until it reaches Surrey Hill, where you will then proceed to the other end of the building and board the smaller carriages and proceed to the downtown.

May 4 - June 11	9:00am until 4:00pm
June 12 – Aug 21	9:00 am until 6:00 pm
Aug 21 - Oct 9	9:00 am until 4:00 pm

\*\* Also included is a coupon for bike rentals at Lakeside Bicycle Rental which is located on our island dock and for a cup of coffee at Marc's Double Oven Bakery in the center of town.
